Backpack
Sleeping Bag
Pillow

 4 scouting or plain T-shirts

 1 long sleeve shirt
 Class A, Webelos slide and neckerchief
 Waterproof shoes or boots for wet mornings
Toiletries:
 toothbrush
 toothpaste
 hairbrush or comb
 soap
 shampoo
 washcloth
 towel
 deodorant
Camera with film and batteries
Rain Coat or Poncho
Insect repellent (non-aerosol)
Swimming gear (swim suit and towel)
Sunscreen
Paper, pencil and WEBELOS BOOK
Small, approved knife with WHITTLINE CHIT
Spending money for Trading Post about \$30.00
Drinking Cups
Refillable Water Bottle
Laundry Bag
Strings for corners of tents
Snacks
Container that locks and seals
Large zip lock bag for book
Large zip lock bags for items to stay dry
Flash Lights
Cards to play for kids in down time
Cards for Adults to play in down time
4 ft Rope
Fishing rods and bait for Tuesday night
Folding Chair for camp site
Some firewood

It is suggested that you put your clothes for a day in a large zip lock bag for each day you will be in camp. That way, you do not have to search for clothes and they will stay dry.

What To Bring To Webelos Camp
